GENESEE COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER OPENS SECOND LOCATION

Genesee County, Michigan – The Genesee Community Health Center (GCHC), part of the Genesee Health System umbrella of services, has opened a new location at 3109 Kleinpell Street in Flint 48507.

GCHC plans their ribbon cutting ceremony and open house on August 20th beginning at 1 PM. The new location officially opened on August 4th.

“This location will serve the residents of the Atherton East Complex and the surrounding neighborhoods,” says Linda Bielskis, Executive Director of GCHC. “The goal is to improve health and health equity through providing high quality, accessible healthcare services and programs to this community.”

The Health Center provides primary healthcare and helps with a myriad of healthcare services including mental health and substance use counseling and referrals. GCHC is a Federally Qualified Health Center, and their first location opened at 422 W. 4th Avenue in Flint in October of 2012.

Genesee Health System provides services and supports to Genesee County residents who are adults and children with developmental disabilities, adults with serious mental illness, children with serious emotional disturbances, and adults and children with substance use disorders. The Genesee Community Health Center is a Federally Qualified Health Center providing primary care. The focus is on the health of the whole person.
